

BY-LAWS of:
Alliance for Injured Motorcyclists Canada
(A.I.M. CAN)

CHAPTER 1 - DEFINITIONS

1.1 Preamble

This is a by-law relating to the transaction of the affairs of the Alliance for Injured Motorcyclists Canada (abbreviated to A.I.M. CAN), a Corporation without share capital, incorporated under the Canada Corporations Act. (Corporate Number: 410869-8)

The Corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members and profits or other accreditation to the Corporation shall be used exclusively in promoting its objectives.

1.2 Definitions

In the By-laws and Policies of the Corporation

- * "National Board" means the Board of Directors of the Corporation;
- * "Local Chapter" means a Local Organization Member (LOM) of the Corporation which complies with the requirements set out in By-law 3.1;
- * "Partisan Political Activity" means directly or indirectly endorsing, supporting or opposing, monetarily or otherwise, a political party or candidates for public office;
- * "Individual Member In Good Standing" means an individual member who has paid or has had paid on their behalf, the dues required by the Corporation for an Individual Member, with their application for membership submitted to the National Headquarters by, or within, sixty (60) days of the original application or yearly renewal date of their Individual Membership.

1.3 Interpretation

In these By-laws, unless the number contexts otherwise require, words importing the singular or the masculine gender shall include the plural number or the feminine gender as the case may be, and vice versa, and the references to persons shall include firms and Corporations.
