

CHAPTER 11 - GENERAL LEGAL COUNSEL

11.1 Duties

1. Legal

The General Legal Counsel shall be the advisor on legal matters pertaining to the Corporation and may attend all General Meetings of the Corporation.

2. Consultative

The General Legal Counsel shall give advice and suggestions to the Corporation and to Local Chapters on the development of constitutions and policies which will give a clear guide for activities.

3. Supervision

The General Legal Counsel shall ensure that the National Board works in accordance with the Constitution and By-laws.

11.2 Specific Qualifications

The General Legal Counsel shall be a Canadian citizen who is a member of a recognized provincial Bar Corporation. Preference shall be given to a person who has previous Local Chapter experience.

11.3 Parliamentarian

A parliamentarian shall be appointed by the presiding officers to serve for the period of the meeting.
