

## **CHAPTER 9 - NATIONAL PRESIDENT**

### **9.1 Duties**

The National President shall serve as the Chief Executive Officer of the Corporation. The National President shall supervise overall operations of the Corporation and shall travel on behalf of the Corporation. The National President shall report to the General Assembly and the Board of Directors. The National President shall execute and administer the policies of the Corporation as established by the General Assembly and the Board of Directors and shall preside over all meetings of the Corporation including the Annual General Meeting.

### **9.2 Specific Qualifications**

A candidate must possess the following qualifications to be eligible for nomination as a National President:

- a) Should have served as a National Vice-President or Regional President within the previous three (3) years.
- b) Must be an Individual Member in good standing.
- c) Notwithstanding By-law 8.10, Section 2, must have been an Individual Member in good standing for the preceding three (3) years.
- d) Must be a member in good standing in a Local Chapter as certified by the Local Chapter President.
- e) Should have served as President of a Local Chapter.

### **9.3 Vacancy**

If, for any reason, other than dismissal, the National President is unable to complete the term of office, the vacancy shall be filled for the remainder of the term in a manner to be decided upon by the National Board.
